Glenkinchie 12 Years Old 43% ABV £4.25

One of the few remaining Lowland distilleries, Glenkinchie's rural location amid fields of barley, just twenty miles from the hustle and bustle of the capital, makes this 'The Edinburgh Malt'. A sweet soft start, like creme anglaise, soon becoming flowery again. A really smooth delivery, especially after adding a drop of water. The mid-palate is crisp and then the flavour settles into a tightly focused bundle of butter icing, lemon cheesecake and freesias.

Auchentoshan American Oak 40% ABV £3.30

Triple distilled and matured solely in American bourbon casks. The result: a Lowland Single Malt Whisky with the sweet aromas of vanilla and coconut - along with the signature smooth, delicate, Auchentoshan taste.

Haig Clubman 40% ABV £3.45

Haig Club Clubman is matured exclusively in American ex-bourbon casks, allowing the sweet, gentle Single Grain Scotch Whisky from Cameronbridge to interact with the vanilla, butterscotch and sweet toffee flavours found in the ex-bourbon casks. The result is a wonderfully smooth, sweet and enjoyable whisky.

Dalwhinnie 15 Year Old 43% ABV £4.25

Dalwhinnie 15 year old is a good introduction to the delights of single malt whisky – elegant, smooth and medium-bodied, with a light, fruity palate and a whiff of heather on the finish. Part of Diageo's Classic Malt range.

Oban 14 Year Old 43% ABV £4.95

The nose is rich and smokey. The medicinal notes are quite evident with notes of the sea; seaweed, tarry ropes. There are notes of cut hay and wood smoke rising with a gentle estery sweetness. The palate is thick and full. Notes of citrus with smooth sweetness. The smoke wafts with notes of seaweed. The oak is quite rich with grist and cereal and malt. The finish is of good length with fruit and dry oak.

ISLAY



Ardbeg Ten Years Old 46% ABV £4.50

Ardbeg Ten Years Old is revered around the world as the peatiest, smokiest, most complex single malt of them all. Yet it does not flaunt the peat; rather it gives way to the natural sweetness of the malt to produce a whisky of perfect balance. Named World Whisky of the Year in 2008.

Laphroaig 40% ABV £4.50

The original Laphroaig, distilled the same way today as when Ian Hunter invented it over 75 years ago. In making Laphroaig, malted barley is dried over a peat fire. The smoke from this peat, found only on Islay, gives Laphroaig its particularly rich flavour. Those enjoying the 10 Year Old will first notice the bold, smoky taste, followed by a hint of seaweed and a surprising sweetness.



CAMPBELTOWN



Springbank 10 Year Old 46% ABV £4.50

This 10 year old offers whisky drinkers the perfect introduction to the Springbank range. Matured in a combination of bourbon and sherry casks, it is perfectly balanced from the first sip through to the full rich finish. Orchard fruit (pear) with a hint of peat, vanilla and malt on the nose, with a palate of malt, oak, spice, nutmeg and cinnamon, vanilla essence. On the finish you have sweet, with a lingering salty tingle.

Highland Park 12 Year Old 40% ABV £3.95



Highland Park 12 Year Old boasts individuality and complexity, thanks in part to the use of Orcadian peat in the distillery floor maltings and the employment of ex-sherry casks for maturation. The nose is fragrant and floral, with hints of heather and some spice. Smooth and honeyed on the palate, with citrus fruits, malt, and distinctive tones of wood smoke in the warm, lengthy, slightly peaty finish.

Jura Origin Aged 10 Years 40% ABV £3.95

Warming golden glow in colour with soft nuances of American white oak with a sweet aroma of honey. Aged in ex bourbon casks, the taste is refined, smooth and clean, with gentle oak flavours, followed by highlights of caramel and soft liquorice. The warmth of roasted coffee beans lingers long in the mouth.

SPEYSIDE



Moray

Macallan Gold 40% ABV £4.25



Lemon citrus, then orange peel and an interlacing sweetness that softens but doesn't eliminate the zest. A quiet note of vanilla is followed by dark chocolate with lingering floral and light oak notes. Citrus and boiled sweets rule the palate, along with hints of ginger and cinnamon, while soft oak tones reveal toasted apples. medium sweet, malty and slightly dry.

Balvenie Doublewood 12 Year Old 43% ABV £4.50

The Balvenie DoubleWood 12 year old single malt whisky gains its distinctive character from being matured in two wood types. The whisky spends at least 12 years in American Oak ex-bourbon barrels and hogsheads, before being moved to Spanish oak ex-Oloroso sherry casks for an additional nine months. The traditional casks soften and add delicate character, the sherry wood brings depth and fullness of flavour and the final few months in our tuns allow the whiskies to marry harmoniously.

BLENDS

Monkey Shoulder 43% ABV £3.45

Some say it tastes like riding bareback on the wild moors of Scotland with a flame haired maiden on Christmas morning. Others agree it tastes like 007 wearing a tuxedo wetsuit. If you haven't tried either yet but want a handy little cheat sheet to check out, here you go! Zesty orange meets mellow vanilla, honey and spiced oak.

Chivas Regal 12 40% ABV £3.45

Chivas Regal 12 is a blend of many different malt and grain Scotch whiskies, matured for at least 12 years. This rich, smooth blend combines style with substance and tradition. This is a very refined blended whisky, with herbs, honey and fruit leaping forth on the palate.

Pogues 50% ABV £3.30

The Pogues Irish Whiskey is a unique blend of 50% 10year single malt Irish whiskey aged in sherry oak casks and 7 year old single malt Irish whiskey aged in bourbon oak casks, and 50% 4 year Irish grain whiskey aged in bourbon oak casks. The liquid has an aroma of malts and cracked nuts, with a sweet taste and a smooth, intense flavour. Notably, West Cork is Ireland's only whiskey producer to malt its own barley, enabling exceptional precision and control over flavour profile. It is distilled using ingredients indigenous to Ireland, including locally grown grain and spring water from the idyllic River Ilen. It's carefully crafted in small batches in handmade copper stills at West Cork's distillery in Skibbereen, the cultural home of Irish whiskey.

Jameson Original 40% ABV £3.30

Jameson Original is a blend of pot still and fine grain whiskeys that is as versatile as it is smooth. Triple-distilled and aged for a minimum of 4 years. To the nose, Jameson has a light floral fragrance, peppered with spicy wood and sweet notes. A perfect balance of spicy, nutty and vanilla notes with hints of sweet sherry and exceptional smoothness.



Hibiki Harmony 43% ABV £5.45

Hibiki Japanese Harmony is a blend of Japanese malt and grain whiskeys from Yamazaki, Hakushu and Chita. Presented in the brand's trademark 24-faceted bottle representing the Japanese seasons, this is light, approachable and moreish with enticing notes of orange peel and white chocolate.

Yamazaki 12 Year Old 43% ABV £6.95

This 12 year old from Yamazaki first came onto the market in 1984 and was the first seriously marketed Japanese single malt whisky. Good body with plenty of nut oils and zest, a pleasant floral character with a little tropical fruit and a rooty note. Smooth and soft with good sweetness and winter spice. A lovely citrus note develops with more tropical fruit notes and a little rum with a medium fruit and zest on the finish.

Bulleit Bourbon 45.6% ABV £3.30

Bulleit Bourbon 10 Year Old is Tom Bulleit's selected reserve. Aged in charred American white oak, select Bulleit Bourbon barrels were set aside to age for 10 years. The result is a special expression of Bulleit that provides a rich, deep, incredibly smooth sipping experience. Deep russet in colour, rich oak aromas, consistently smooth taste with vanilla, dried fruit, and a long, smoky finish.

Bulleit Rye 45% ABV £3.45

Bulleit Rye is an award-winning, straight rye whiskey with a character of unparalleled spice and complexity. Released in 2011, it continues to enjoy recognition as one of the highest quality ryes available. Russet in colour, with rich oak aromas. The taste is exceptionally smooth, with hints of vanilla, honey, and spice. Finish is crisp and clean, with long, lingering flavours.

Jack Daniel's 40% ABV £3.30

"We've always done things a little differently. But it's the extra steps we take that give Jack its distinctive character and unique taste. We charcoal mellow all our whiskey drop by drop, before aging it in our own handcrafted American white oak barrels. We don't rely on calendars to tell us when our whiskey is ready. Only a sip from our tasters can tell us that. And when you take a sip, we think you'll appreciate why we do the things we do. Balanced caramel, vanilla and toasted oak. Medium bodied with creamy clean finish."

Jack Daniel's Honey 35% ABV £3.30

"When we launched our first foray into flavours it certainly created quite a buzz around the Distillery. Since then, it's had the same effect wherever it's landed. Jack Daniel's Tennessee Honey is a finely crafted blend of Old No.7 and a unique honey liqueur of our own making. It's a taste that's truly one-of-a-kind but unmistakably Jack. Honey-sweet with a distinctively smooth finish, this particular Jack is best enjoyed when it's chilled and shared. Yellowish golden. Rich notes of natural honey, sweet molasses and roasted nuts glaze the distinctive nose of classic Jack Daniel's. Our original Tennessee Whiskey recipe balanced with honey and delicate hints of molasses, chocolate and pralines followed by smooth, long trails of rich honey and nut character."
